Subject: [EXTERNAL] Affidavit for Verisign

Hi Mike,

Namecheap recently acquired the transfer rights for all Namecheap-managed domains on the eNom platform, which we understand is now owned by Tucows. And, we understand that Tucows assumed eNom's contractual obligations to Namecheap as eNom's successor. Both eNom and Namecheap understand the acquisition to be a "Qualifying Event" for purposes of the BTAPPA service as have other registries. Here, non-Verisign TLDs have already been transferred to Namecheap under the terms of the Event, but we note that Verisign's BTAPPA guidelines require us to provide details of the Qualifying Event in the form of an affidavit. Such details appear below and we ask you to confirm that this is the level of detail needed for the affidavit.

Namecheap has acted as a reseller for eNom for a number of years now. In July 2015, Namecheap and eNom entered a written agreement whereby the parties provided terms where Namecheap would acquire the right to transfer all Namecheap-managed customer domains. Consideration was negotiated and paid by Namecheap. In exchange for the transfer rights to Namecheap-managed customer domains, Namecheap agreed that all new registrations, transfers and renewals of specified TLDs would take place exclusively on the eNom platform through December 31, 2016 ("Closing Date"). eNom, in return, gave its written consent to transfer all Namecheap-managed customer domains residing on the eNom platform to Namecheap in any manner designated by Namecheap upon Namecheap's subsequent request. To date, Namecheap has completed no less than seven bulk transfers with the approval of other registries from eNom to Namecheap. We are in the process of completing the bulk transfer of all remaining TLDs under this same event.

So, for purposes of the required Verisign affidavit, an authorized Namecheap representative will attest, (i) Namecheap is ICANN-accredited for the subject TLDs and is in good standing; (ii) eNom and Namecheap both consented in writing to Namecheap's right to acquire transfer rights in a partial domain portfolio consisting of the domains that are managed by Namecheap in its reseller capacity; and (iii) Namecheap rendered full consideration to eNom.

Can you please let us know sometime this week if these details are sufficient for the affidavit so that we can go ahead and prepare it?

We believe they should be, but can certainly add additional details if necessary. Please confirm.
